**BETA SERIES** often called betathane, is the closest thing to leather in the equine marketplace. Since its inception in 1999, beta series has steadily gained the trust of halter and tack makers alike. The main attribute is the soft-to-the-hand feel beta series is equipped with. This comes from the 60A durometer PVC coating. The coating has a classic leather grain emboss pattern on the surface making it difficult to tell beta from real leather.

**GOLD SERIES** is the classic genuine BioThane coating. All gold series products are **GLOSSY** in appearance and they feature excellent abrasion resistance and flexibility. The gold series belting is coated exclusively with urethane. The **URETHANE** shield has a hardness rating of 85A durometer, which is great for cutting, punching and welding. There are plenty of **COLORS** to choose from in the gold series. The gold opaque colors are referred as '100 series' and the gold translucent colors are referred as '300 series'.

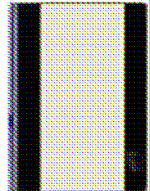


**GRANITE SERIES** may appear pure and soft, but don't let it fool you. Widely popular for its rich matte black surface, granite series is designed for heavy-duty jobs. Granite series employs a urethane shield, which has virtually zero 'tackiness'. Unlike gold and diamond series, the surface of granite features a **LEATHER GRAIN** emboss pattern. With a hardness rating of 83A durometer, granite is excellent for cutting, sewing, welding and riveting.

Black 101 with reflective strip 3/4" only:



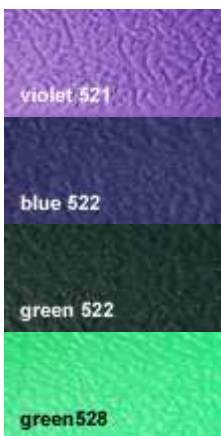
This can be used on bridles & halters (brow and nose-bands only), halters, breastplates. It is not an overlay.
